Georgia VoteSafe Program. State law requires the public availability of voter lists, including names and addresses of registered voters. In 2009, the Georgia Legislature enacted a bill known as the VoteSafe program to provide for the confidentiality of residence addresses of certain registered voters who have been, or may be subject to acts of family violence or stalking or currently reside in a family violence shelter. On-Line Voter Registration. Use the State of Georgia's Online Voter Registration System at <https://registertovote.sos.ga.gov> to register to vote, make changes to your current registration record, check if you are registered to vote, find out your polling place and directions and other information about state elected officials.

VOTER IDs. Bring one of these six forms of identification to vote at the polls:

* **Any valid state or federal government-issued photo ID** [including a free ID Card issued by your county registrar's office or the Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS)]. If you do not have such an ID, or one of the other starred items here, you can receive a state-issued photo ID (free of charge) from your county registrar's office or the Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS) by providing :

- A photo identity document or approved non-photo identity document that includes full legal name and date of birth.
- Documentation showing the voter's date of birth.
- Evidence that the applicant is a registered voter.
- Documentation showing the applicant's name and residential address.

* **A Georgia Driver's License, even if expired.**

* **Valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia, or any county municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state.**

* **Valid U.S. passport ID.**

* **Valid U.S. military photo ID.**

* **Valid tribal photo ID.**
