



An Interview with Dr. Brendan Kelly, University of West Georgia

Due to social distancing guidelines and other restrictions because of the pandemic, our quarterly membership breakfast format changed and turned into an opportunity to get to know Dr. Brendan Kelly, the new president of the University of West Georgia. The event was hosted by Daniel Jackson, President/CEO of the Carroll Chamber and VP at United Community Bank and current 2020 Carroll Chamber Board Chair, Kirby Butler.

Prior to joining UWG, Dr. Kelly served as chancellor of the University of South Carolina Upstate, the largest regional comprehensive university in the USC system. During his tenure as chancellor, USC Update attained the highest levels of enrollment in the history

of the institution, as well as increased fundraising for the institution's endowment and annual fund.

Dr. Kelly explained that any public university is considered a community asset, and he understands how intentional they a university must be in creating value for the community. Since taking on the new position, Dr. Kelly has focused on stabilizing the organization as they saw one of the most extensive budget cuts in history.


