To schedule a ribbon cutting with the Carroll County Chamber of Commerce, we ask for a minimum of two weeks prior to the event to ensure no conflict of scheduling and to give the Chamber time to prepare an address label template for you.

Chamber staff will help to make things go as smoothly as possible. Our team will:

- Notify the Chamber's Board of Directors and Ambassadors, city dignitaries and local media via e-mail. We will encourage them to attend your event, but cannot guarantee their attendance.
- Provide a mailing label template for the city officials of your choice.
- Bring the giant scissors and take pictures at the appointed time. We are happy to provide scissors for after hour ribbon cuttings—they must be returned the following business day.

Notes: Pictures will be emailed to you upon request. In addition, we will contact the media, but cannot guarantee their attendance. Chamber members will also have their event photos included in the Chamber News for the following month. As an added benefit for members, we will promote your event via our Monday eblast.

Checklist for a Successful Ribbon Cutting

- Consider sending invitations to the following: Neighbor businesses, existing customers, suppliers to your business, prospective customers, personal family and friends, and elected officials.
- Plan refreshments and giveaways if appropriate.
- If ribbon cutting is planned for the front of the business, block off parking spaces in order to have space for the ceremony and photographs.
- To ensure Chamber staff attendance, ribbon cuttings should be scheduled Tuesday through Thursday 10:00 am- 4:00 pm.

The Chamber offers a drug-free workplace program, "Drugs Don't Work." Participants receive a 7.5 percent discount on worker's compensation insurance when completing the certification process to become a "Drugs Don't Work" site.

Eblasts

Over 1200 member representatives receive the Monday Eblasts each week. Members are invited to submit information on upcoming events and special happenings. Member updates are on a first-come, first-served basis and are limited to the first five submissions each week.
