 - A photo identity document or approved non-photo identity document that includes full legal name and date of birth.
 - Documentation showing the voter's date of birth. - Evidence that the applicant is a registered voter.

 - Documentation showing the applicant's name and residential address.
- * A Georgia Driver's License, even if expired.
- * Valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia, or any county municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state.
- Valid U.S. passport ID.
- Valid U.S. military photo ID.
- * Valid tribal photo ID.
