If you are selected as part of our exclusive 15-person cohort, you will be responsible for attending all sessions throughout the year, ensuring a comprehensive and immersive learning experience.

As a 2025 L.I.F.T. Program member, tuition is payable upon selection. Tuition must be paid in full before the first session on January 30. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable and is the participant's responsibility upon acceptance.
